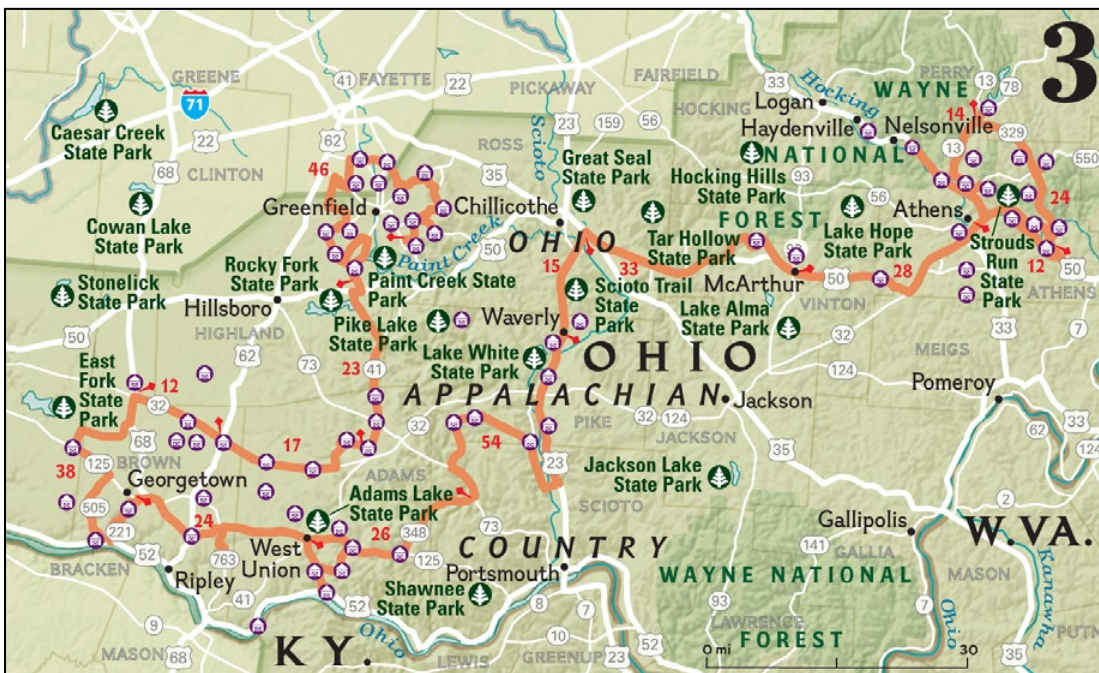


Ohio: Clothesline of Quilts

Give Donna Sue Groves credit for this tribute to her mother, which began with a painted quilt square on the family farm's barn in Manchester. Now more than 20 barns in Adams County are decorated, each with a different pattern, creating a quilt sampler that honors this Appalachian tradition. Travel on state routes and side roads through five counties to find more of the Pinwheel, LeMoyné Stars, Windmill, Hour Glass, and other unique pattern designs. The idea birthed in Ohio and now spreading across Appalachia - created an unexpected surge to preserve the barns on which the squares are painted, while linking the shared heritage of the region.
